

Your Guide to the Personal Health Information Protection Act

▶ What is the Personal Health Information Protection Act (PHIPA)?

PHIPA is a law that gives you control over your personal health information. It sets out how health care providers, hospitals, and other organizations that collect, use, and disclose your personal health information must do so.

PHIPA applies to all health care providers, hospitals, and other organizations that collect, use, and disclose your personal health information. It also applies to health information that is collected, used, and disclosed by these organizations.

- It gives you the right to access your personal health information.
- It gives you the right to correct your personal health information.
- It gives you the right to withdraw your consent to the collection, use, and disclosure of your personal health information.
- It gives you the right to complain if you believe your personal health information has not been handled properly.

▶ How does PHIPA apply to you?

PHIPA applies to you if you are a resident of Ontario and you have provided your personal health information to a health care provider, hospital, or other organization that is subject to PHIPA. ▶ What are the key principles of PHIPA?

The key principles of PHIPA are: 1. Accountability: Health care providers, hospitals, and other organizations that collect, use, and disclose your personal health information are responsible for ensuring that your personal health information is handled properly. 2. Consent: Health care providers, hospitals, and other organizations that collect, use, and disclose your personal health information must obtain your consent before they do so.

▶ What are the key rights of PHIPA?

The key rights of PHIPA are: 1. Access: You have the right to access your personal health information. 2. Correction: You have the right to correct your personal health information. 3. Withdrawal of consent: You have the right to withdraw your consent to the collection, use, and disclosure of your personal health information. 4. Complaint: You have the right to complain if you believe your personal health information has not been handled properly.
